Minimum requirements include:

- 30 credits of undergraduate university classes with a minimum 3.0 (75%) GPA.
- Regardless of the level of education attained candidates must have three credit hours in the following subjects: human biology, calculus based mathematics, physics and a social science.
- Applicants whom English is an additional language must meet the University of Toronto English language assessment requirements.

Successful applicants will have a good background in the sciences, strong technical skills and the ability to work with care and precision. Patience, tolerance as well as strong interpersonal, communication and teamwork skills are important to have.
